What is a Veteran?

- Active duty (regular military service, National Guard, and Reserves)
- Veteran (honorably discharged)
- Family member of veteran/active duty (dependents)

My parent is a Veteran, can I get any assistance?

- Parent is 100% disabled or served post 9/11

What is the Admissions process?

- Apply online www.utm.edu/advantage
- Pay application fee (\$30) **Fee waived for Veterans only**
- Admission requirements: <http://www.utm.edu/departments/admissions/freshman.php>
- Send all transcripts (high school, military, other institutions)
- Send all ACT/Sat scores to UT Martin

Steps to Complete for Financial Aid Process

- File the FAFSA <https://fafsa.ed.gov/>
- Receive Award Letter
- Accept Your Award
- Review additional information at <https://www.utm.edu/departments/finaid/howtoapply.php>

How do I order a military transcript?

How do I get started using my GI benefits?

- Go to va.gov
- Create a benefits account (go to Get Started button under Benefits)
- Complete online application (forward confirmation email; letter will arrive approximately 4-6 weeks)
- Receive certificate of eligibility (needed to use the GI Bill)
- Request DD214 or NOBE (active duty will have NOBE)

When will I start receiving my money?

- Chapter 33 benefits tuition comes to the school
- Funds are dispersed from the VA to account established during application process for chapter 33 benefits for book stipend and housing allowance.
- Chapter 1606 or 1607 (call monthly to verify enrollment 1-877-823-2378). Funds will be dispersed to account established during application process.

- Chapter 35 monthly funds go to account established during application process.
- Upon certification by the school certifying official, the student can obtain payment status through VA student hotline at 1-888-442-4551. This can normally occur 3-5 days after certification.

How many months of benefits do I have remaining?

- Student must call to find how many months they have left through the student hotline at 1-888-442-4551 or at va.gov.
